# **Auditions**

Production, Team, Company, and Senior Company

Auditions are for 2014-2015 and ages 4 & up

Our company will perform at competition, conventions, local arts festivals and community events.

#### **Selection Criteria**

- Dancers will be chosen based on skill level, age, attitude, and personal drive
- Dancers may compete across several categories

#### Registration

- When/How do I register for audition?
  - You may register for auditions after reading the registration packet
    - Packets must be completed and turned in before June 3rd
    - Pay \$25 tryout fee

#### **Tryout Clinic Info**

- All Dancers
  - o Clinic and Auditions will all be held on one day.
- Clinic information
  - The clinic is not meant to be difficult, it is structured to teach basic dance fundamentals and tryout material that judges will be evaluating.
  - O What will be taught?
    - Dance steps needed to perform the tryout dance
    - A tryout piece
    - Proper technique used in leaps and turns
  - Clinic and audition are closed to observers.
  - o Dress Code
    - Solid color leotard or dance top
    - Solid color dance shorts, capris, or pants
    - Dance shoes
    - Hair pulled back off of face
  - o Tryout Requirements (Remember that this material will be taught)
    - Ages 4-7
      - Single pirouette
      - Right/Left leaps
      - Right/Left splits
      - Dance taught at clinic
    - Ages 8-12
      - Double pirouette
      - Right, Left, and Center leaps
      - All splits
      - Illusion
      - Two Fouette turns
      - Dance taught at clinic
    - Ages 13 and up
      - Triple pirouette
      - Right, Left, Center, and switch leaps
      - Switch center leap
      - All splits
      - Illusion
      - Four Fouette turns
      - Turn sequence
      - Dance taught at clinic

## **Senior Company**

- Ages 12 and Up
- Must Be Enrolled In the Pre-Professional Program
- Will Perform at 2-4 Competitions, Attend 1-2 Conventions and 3-5 Local Community Events
- Weekly Rehearsals
- Must Attend the Summer Intensive, Fall Workshop, and Spring Workshop
- Minimum of 4 Group Dances
- \$20/month Rehearsal Fee Per Dance
- \$100 Choreography Fee Per Dance
- \$75 and up Costume
- \$25 Studio Fee Per Competition/Convention Plus \$5 Per Group Dance
- \$45 Average Competition Entry Fee



- Bring a copy of your birth certificate. I must be able to prove ages, if we are questioned.
- If you are unable to make a practice due to a reasonable excuse (Director will determine if excusable), you must contact the instructor prior to the absence. If you do not contact either the instructor or the Director, you may be suspended from the team indefinitely.
- You are allowed only four absences from rehearsal. The first three absences will result in a warning, and the fourth will result in a dismissal from the team.
- Any missed class must be made up.
- An unexcused absence from a competition will result in suspension from the team.
- Sickness is excused from practice, competition, and/or special event at Miss Brie's discretion.
- Arriving 15 minutes late to practice, competition, and/or special event will be assessed an absence.
- Arriving late to practice will result in some form of conditioning. No Exceptions.
- You are expected to have a positive attitude at all times.
- You are expected to give 110% during practice, as well as competitions.
- Excessive socialization (as determined by the instructor) during practices will result in some form of conditioning.
- No cell phones or other devices are allowed to be used during class or practice. This includes any water breaks. Phones may be quickly checked for important messages between classes.
- No jewelry is to be worn at any time during practice.
- Be completely ready to perform (hair, costume, makeup, warmed up, etc.) at least one hour before
  you are scheduled to perform. You never know when a competition will be running early, and you
  must perform when they get to your dance. If you will be getting ready at the competition, arrive
  much earlier. YOU MUST BE ABLE TO WALK ON STAGE 1-HOUR BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED TIME.
- If you win an award doing a solo, it is yours to keep unless it is an overall. All other trophies are kept at the studio. All students should cooperate in getting a picture of each group routine. We could then put the picture with the trophy.
- If you are missing any of your costume, you will not be allowed to perform if we cannot make all dancers alike. Missing headpieces, incorrect shoes, missing gloves, wrong tights etc.
- Your attitude and behavior to others is very important to me. We expect you to represent the studio and yourself with respect. Compliment other studios' dancers, and be willing to meet new people. If they do not respond nicely, just let it go, and don't be rude back to them. Also, it goes without

saying that you should support your classmates. Competition is not the time to bicker with each other. You should come together and support each other.

- Audience behavior: Follow organizations rules, always, no videoing. Remember to get up and move around between routines only. Students and their guests should applaud for others. (believe it or not, some studios don't applaud for others)
- Show respect to all faculty members, your parents, and all students at the studio.
- For our parents...Our competitive program requires a positive atmosphere from all involved. Cooperation between all parents is expected at all times. Please show respect for faculty members, other parents and all dancers. A positive and enthusiastic outlook on this program extends to your child. Negative comments and feedback can be harmful to your child's progress and education.
- Most communication among the studio and parents shall be conducted via email and
  Dropbox Please be sure to check your email regularly for information and any updates. If you do
  not have access to email, please be sure to inform the studio. General information for our studio
  and the competition program is also available in your Dropbox folder. For any specific inquiries and
  questions, please contact Ms. Brie.
- Last minute withdrawals from any competition/convention will not be tolerated. Serious injuries or family tragedies are the only exceptions. Solos are exempt from this rule. All entry fees are nonrefundable due to each competition's policies.
- Dancers are not allowed to teach at any other dance studio and/or business organization without The Directors permission and consent.
- Dancers are not allowed to take class at other studios without Miss Brie's permission and consent. This is a conflict of interest with our competitive program.
- All Competition teams students and parents are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous and respectable manner at all times. Gossiping by a student or a parent about other students, parents, staff members or other studios is not tolerated. Disrespecting a faculty member or another student or being discourteous to a fellow student is grounds for disciplinary action that may result in probation, suspension or being asked to leave the studio permanently. In the event that you are asked to not return to the studio there will be no reimbursement for any classes, fees for the recital, choreography fees or any other fees by the studio or paid for by the studio. Any balance on your account will be due immediately. If your costume is paid in full but has not come in yet, we will call you when it comes in and you can pick up the costume.
- All posted studio rules must be followed at all times.
- Punishment for any rules violation may include but is not limited to conditioning and studio service time.
